## Possible Support for Business Enterprise Projects with local schools

Marion Child, the Project Officer of the Education Business Partnership is looking to recruit business men and woman to volunteer to help at business enterprise events I am running at local schools. The aim of the business 'mentor' is to be there to help advise pupils on a specific project, or to undertake judging of presentations. Anyone who has a head for business is ideal to volunteer to help us. The projects are normally simple in structure, i.e. a team of 10 pupils would need to work together to produce a specific outcome, such as creating an idea around a specific theme, marketing (posters, business cards, adverts etc), finance considerations and normally creating a short presentation to present their ideas to a panel of judges.

They don't tend to use specialists for each topic, rather just a business minded person who can help guide the teams, help the teams focus and give suggestions for areas to consider.

Local events are on the following dates and wondered whether you, or one of your colleagues may be able to help as a business mentor for either the full day (9 - 3.30) or the morning or afternoon sessions.

Monday 30/04/07: Chesham High School - Community Challenge for Year 10 pupils, to produce and market a board game for the local Ley Hill primary school

Monday 21/05/07: Holmer Green Senior School - Enterprise Challenge for Year 10 pupils, to develop and market a European Tour for a new band.

Tuesday 26/06/07: Chesham Park Community College - Enterprise Challenge for Year 10 pupils, to design, plan and market a stadium for the 2012 Olympics

Thursday 28/06/07: St Mary's Independent School, Gerrards Cross - Enterprise Challenge for Year 9 and 10 pupils, to develop and market a European Tour for a new band.

Monday 02/07 - Wednesday 04/07: Beaconsfield High School – Enterprise and Curriculum challenge for Year 10 pupils, to develop and market a European Tour for a new band. (Different business mentors required on each day.)
